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Jersey City Mayor Healy Cuts Ribbon to Open Crystal Point Sales Center

JERSEY CITY -- Jersey City Mayor Jerramiah Healy recently joined representatives of Fisher Development Associates to celebrate the opening of a new sales and model center for Crystal Point, the new 42-story condominium building which is rising on the last piece of developable waterfront land facing the New York City skyline in this Hudson County City.
